**To coincide with the Frieze Art fair, the critically acclaimed contemporary Indian artist Vanita Gupta will exhibit at The Gallery in Redchurch Street in her first solo show in London. The exhibition is presented by the London based Rob Dean Art Ltd and the Bombay based Pundole Art Gallery.**

Vanita Gupta states of her work 'I believe in the ardent need to paint, nothing more nothing less'. Although Vanita claims to work in a completely 'non-objective' manner, her monochromatic paintings have a compelling need to be interpreted. It is an imagery that demands ones attention and requires decoding. In her recent large-scale canvases there is an echo of the traditional form of Japanese calligraphy, *Sousho*, merged with elements of urban graffiti.
